
#### Day-6

It was last day of camp ,Camp include, presentation on history, geography, economy, good practices, cultural heritage, festivals, customs & traditions of the states. Learning the


language of each other viz Marathi and Hindi and Interaction in language is one of the highlights of the camp. There was closing address by Prayagraj Group.
