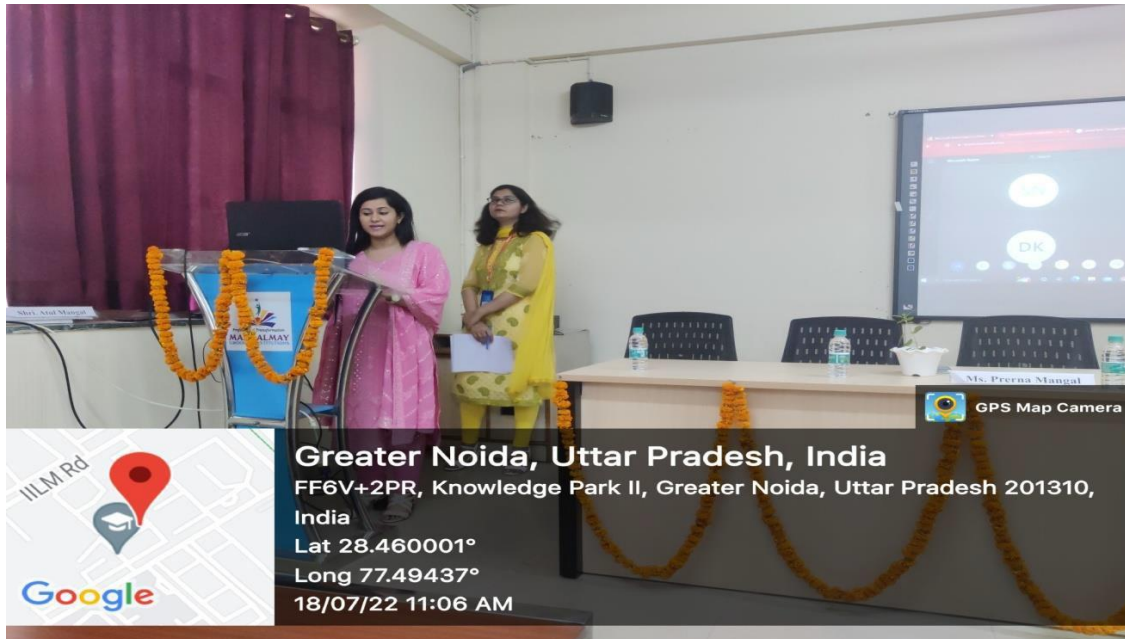

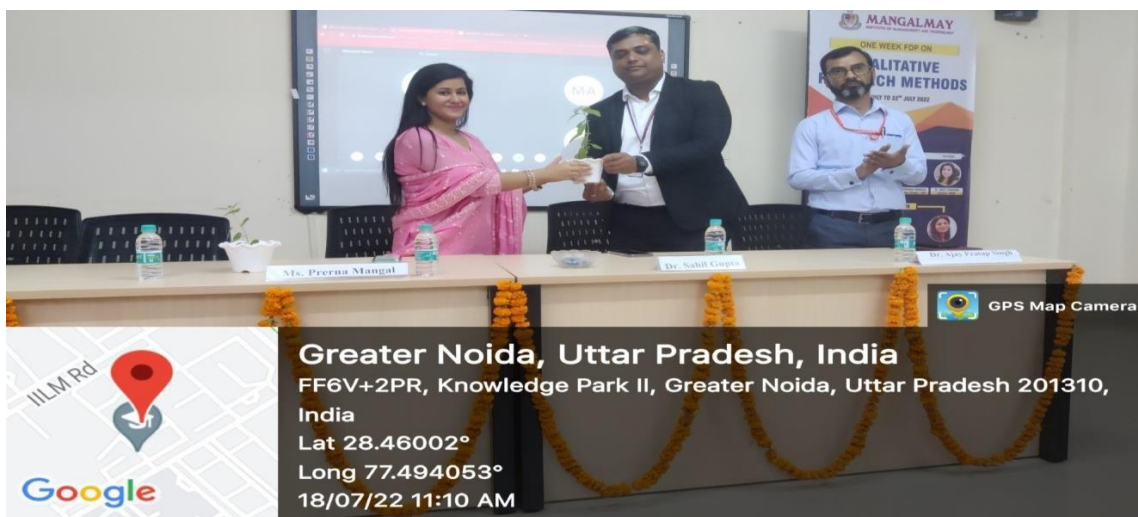

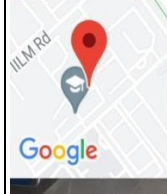

- Analyze and organize unstructured text, audio, video, or image data.
- Playback ability for audio and video files, so that interviews can be transcribed in NVIVO.
- Ability to capture social media data from Facebook and Twitter using the NCapture browser plug- in.
- Import notes and captures from Evernote - great for field research.
- Import citations from EndNote, Mendeley, Zotero, or other bibliographic management software - great for literature reviews.

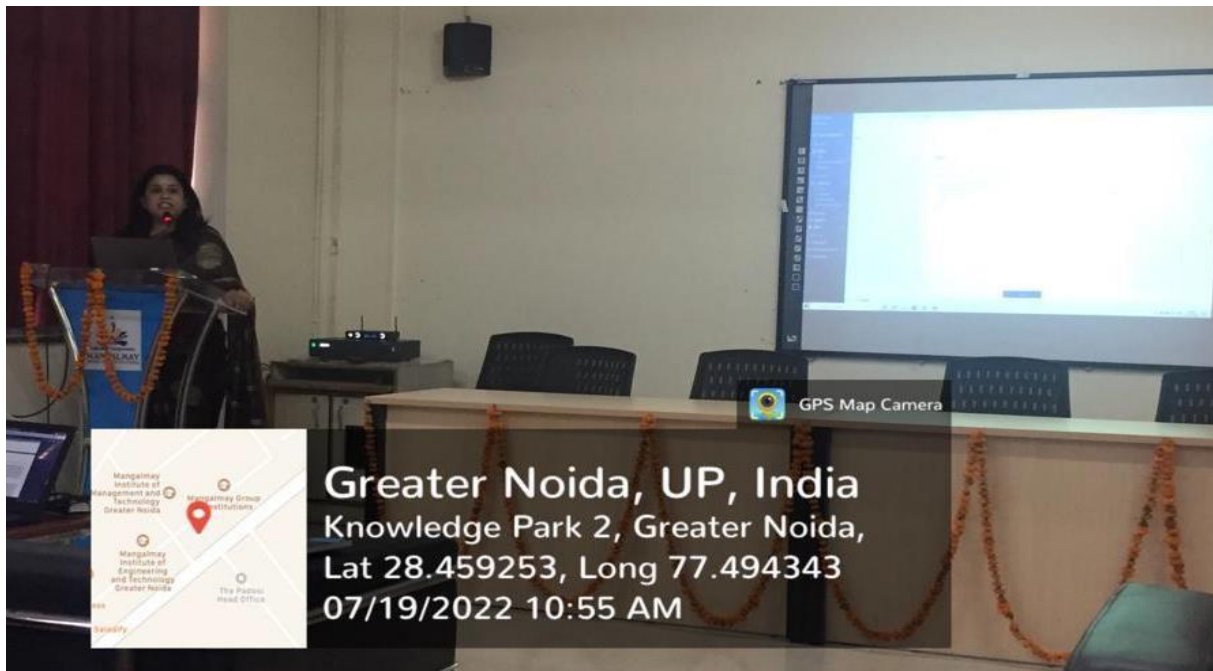

Firstly, he explained the concept and role of Thematic Analysis in qualitative research. He describe that Thematic analysis is a qualitative data analysis method that involves reading through a data set (such as transcripts from in depth interviews or focus groups), and identifying patterns in meaning across the data to derive themes.



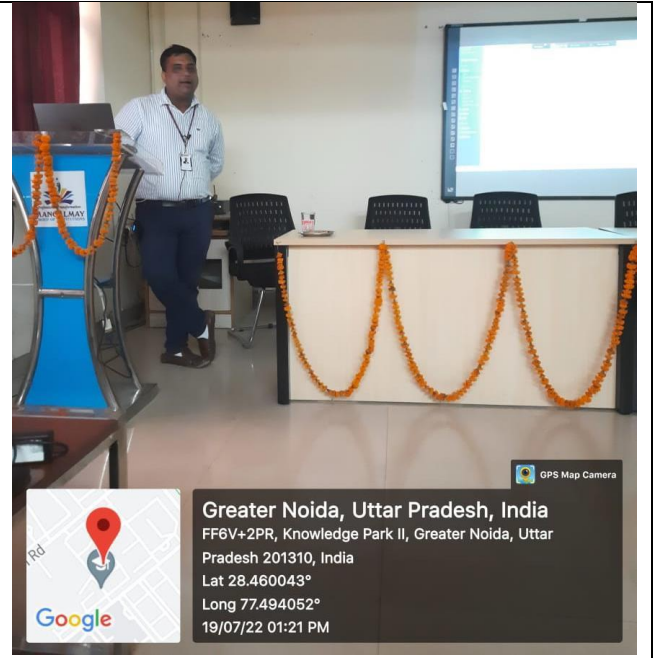
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Thematic analysis involves an active process of reflexivity, where a researcher's subjective experience plays a central role in meaning making from data. Thematic analysis was widely used in the field of psychology as well as other fields that use qualitative research methods. Also, he explained the situations and scenarios where Thematic Analysis should use. After that, he explained about the role of Social Media Analysis and Mendeley Referencing in research process.

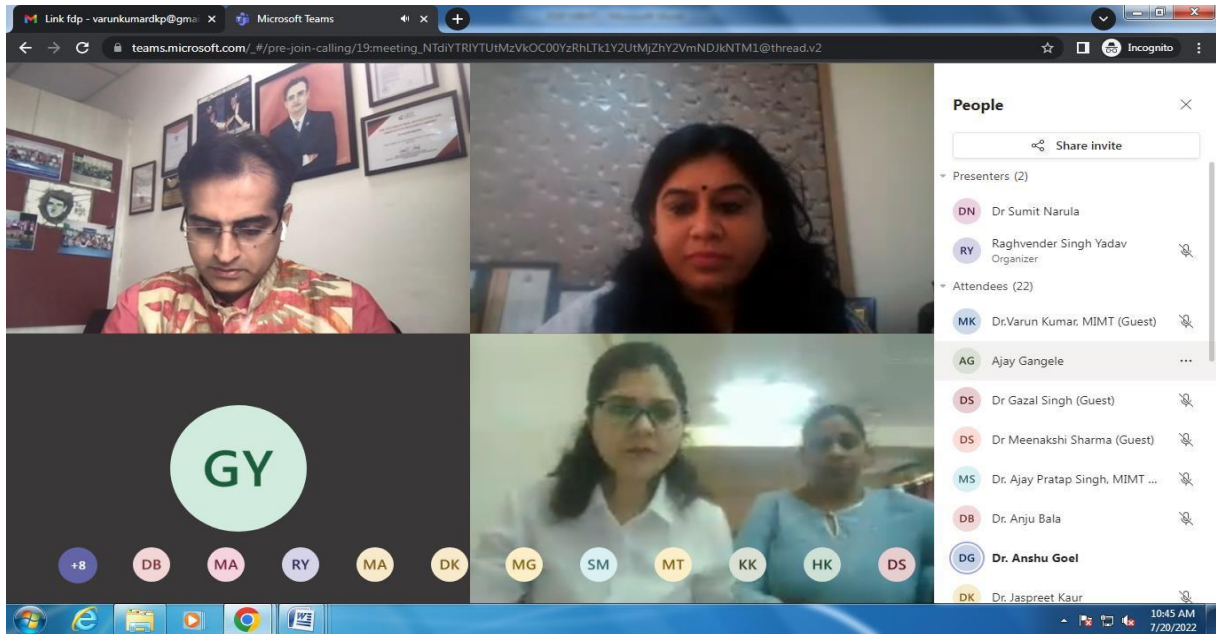

In Technical Session, Dr. Sumit Narula, Director- Amity School of Communication, Gwalior had started his lecture with the introduction of Research Writing Ethics. He explained the role of ethics in research writing with very energetic manner. He also explained the principles for research ethics with examples. He explained Research ethics relates to questions about how researchers formulate and clarify their research topic, research design and gain access, collects data, process and store data, analyzes data and write up research findings in a moral and responsible way. This means that researcher will have to ensure that the way you design your research is both methodologically sound and morally defensible to all those who are involved.

After the discussion of Research Writing Ethics, he started the explanation regarding Fake and Predatory Journal Practices with systematic presentation. Firstly, he defined the meaning of fake and predatory journal and how can we identify fake and Predatory Journal. Also, he explained the Checklist to Identify Fake Journal. He explained point to point Characteristics of Predatory Journals.

Dr. Pooja Goel, Associate Professor, Delhi University was the resources person for the Day-04. In starting of Day-04, Ms.Sonali Chauhan, Faculty-MIMT gave the brief introduction of resource person to the audience.

In Technical Session, Dr. Pooja Goel, Associate Professor, Delhi University had started his lecture with the introduction of Systematic Literature review (SLR). She explained different types of Literature review and role of SLR in quantitative research. She explained Systematic literature review is a basic scientific activity that allows scientists to view the “lay of the land” in a particular area. It identifies, evaluates, and synthesizes research results to create a summary of current evidence that can contribute to evidence- based practice. Systematic review methodology employs the same principles and rigor required in primary research. Typically, systematic literature reviews address narrow research questions (i.e., “Does the current literature prove that treatment ‘x’ works better than treatment ‘z’?”) that are typically answered using meta-analysis techniques with evidence from randomized controlled trials using similar outcome measures.

She had proposed three premises for conducting systematic reviews: (a) to reduce large amounts of information into comprehensible units, (b) to aggregate critical information for decision-making and (c) to efficiently move from knowledge discovery to implementation.

Day-05

In starting of Day-05, Dr. Pooja Goel, Associate Professor, Delhi University started her lecture on the topic of Meta Analysis in qualitative research. She defined qualitative meta-analysis is an attempt to conduct a rigorous secondary qualitative analysis of primary qualitative findings. She also explained the purpose of Meta Analysis in qualitative research. She presented the distinctive features of conducting meta-analysis approaches. Several considerations important for conducting qualitative meta-analysis were also discussed. She used examples of the first experiences attempted with qualitative meta-analysis in the field of research.

Then post lunch, She explained the concept and role of Bibliometric Analysis in research. She also explained the importance of biblioshiny analysis. She defined biblioshiny is a shiny app providing a web-interface for bibliometrix. It supports scholars in easy use of the main features of bibliometrix: Data importing and conversion to data frame collection. Data gathering using Dimensions, PubMed and Scopus APIs collection. At the end of the technical session, many participants were asked questions to the resources person and she answered them with very enthusiastic manner.

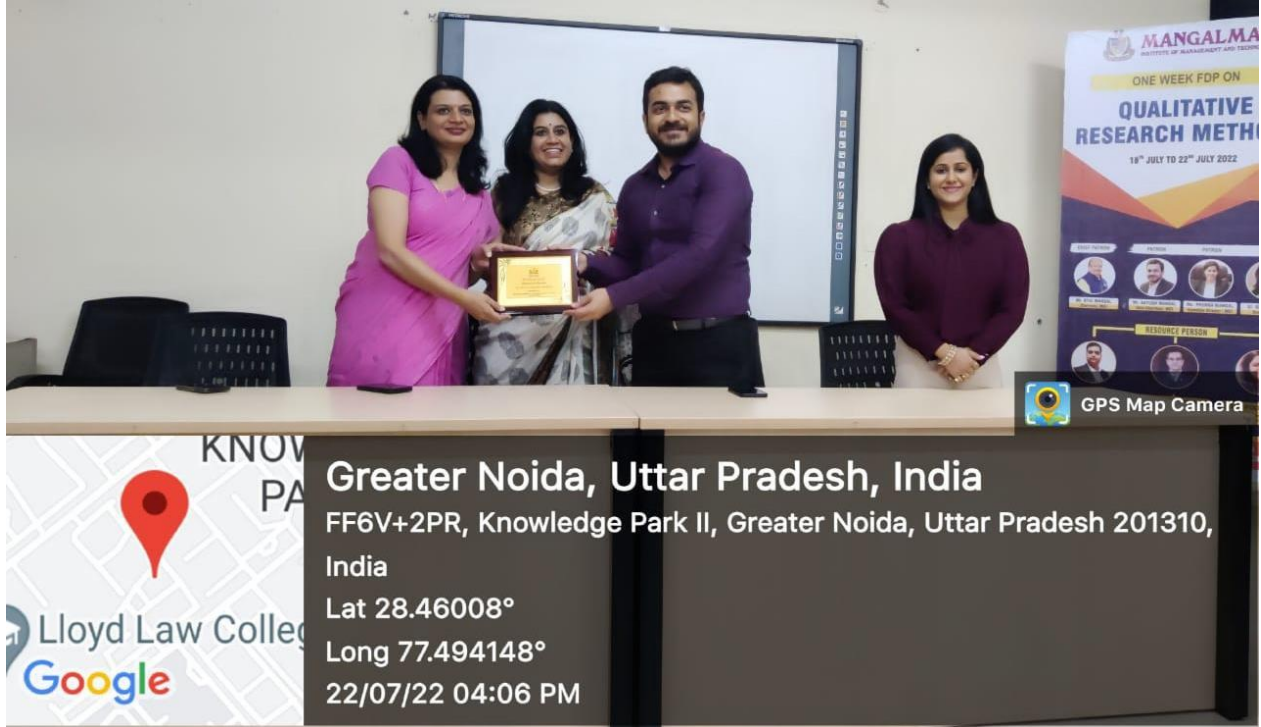

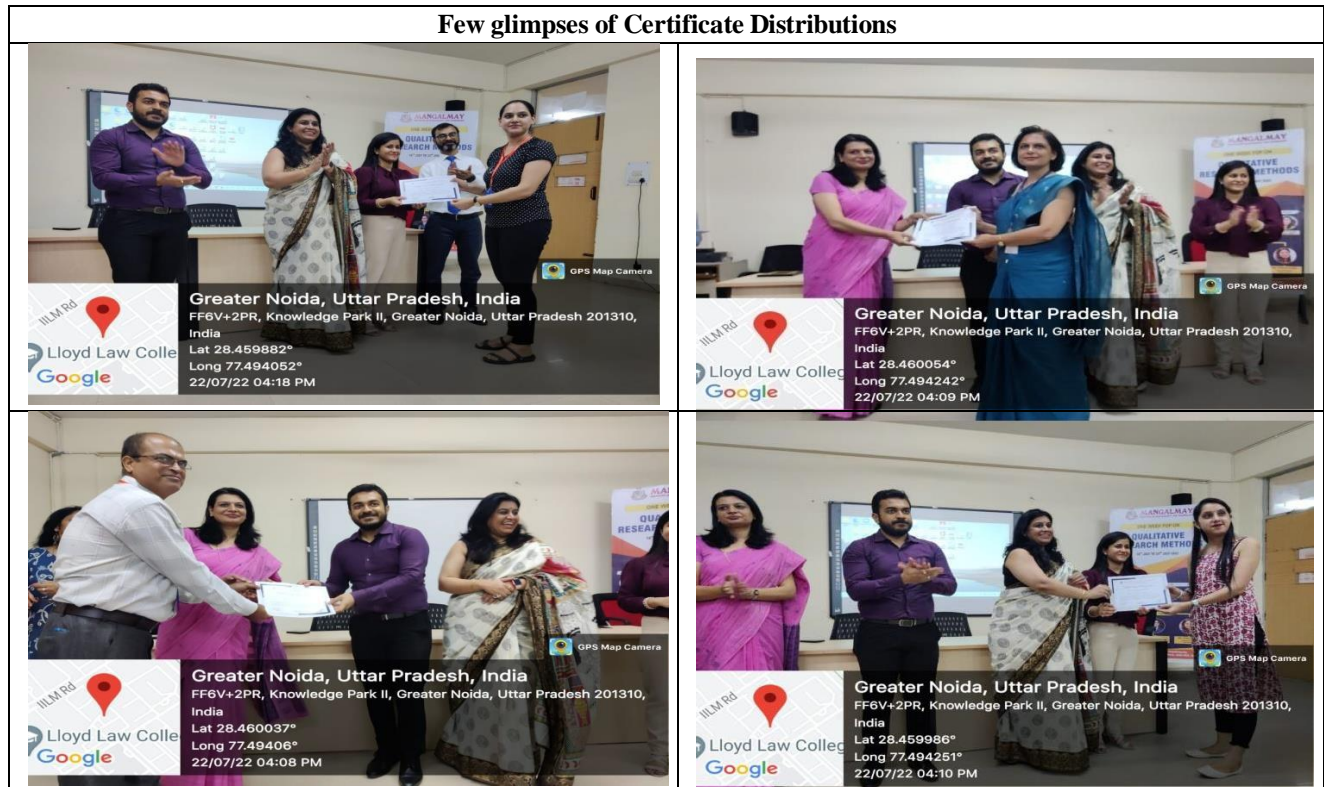

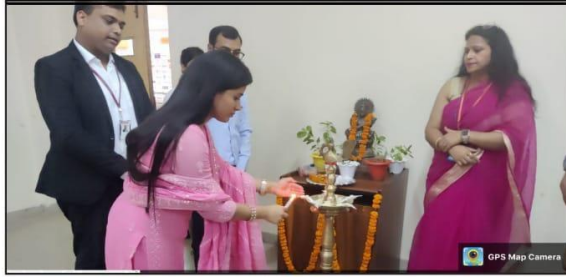
