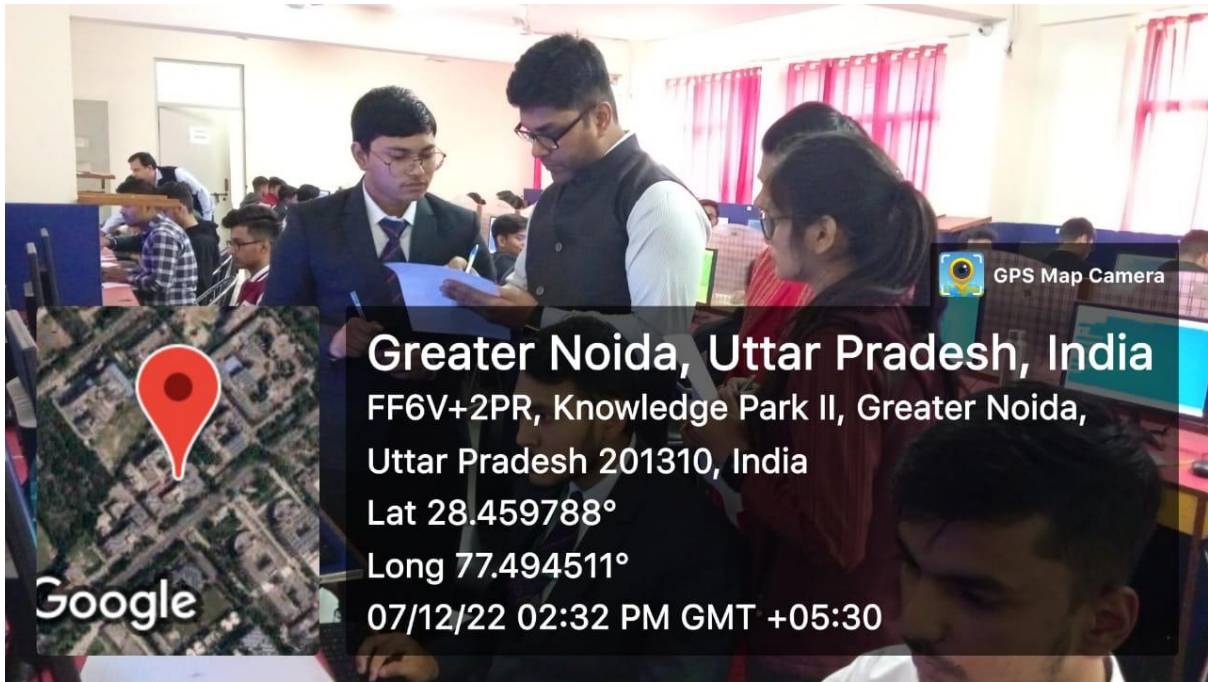


Figure 2 During coding competition Ms. SurajShukla and Ms. Soniya Sharma evaluated the problem solved by Harsh student of BCA 1 year.

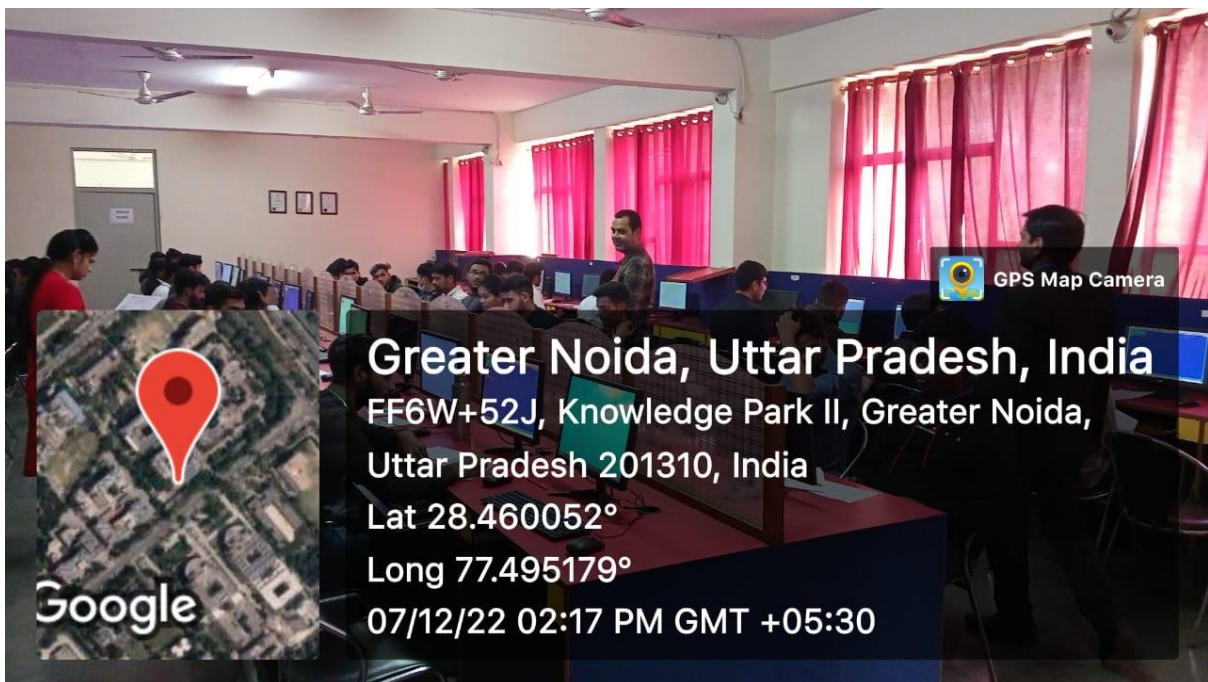


Figure 3 During Coding Competition Ms. Soniya Sharma, Ms. Ravi Bhushan and Mr. Himanshu Tiwari with the participated students.



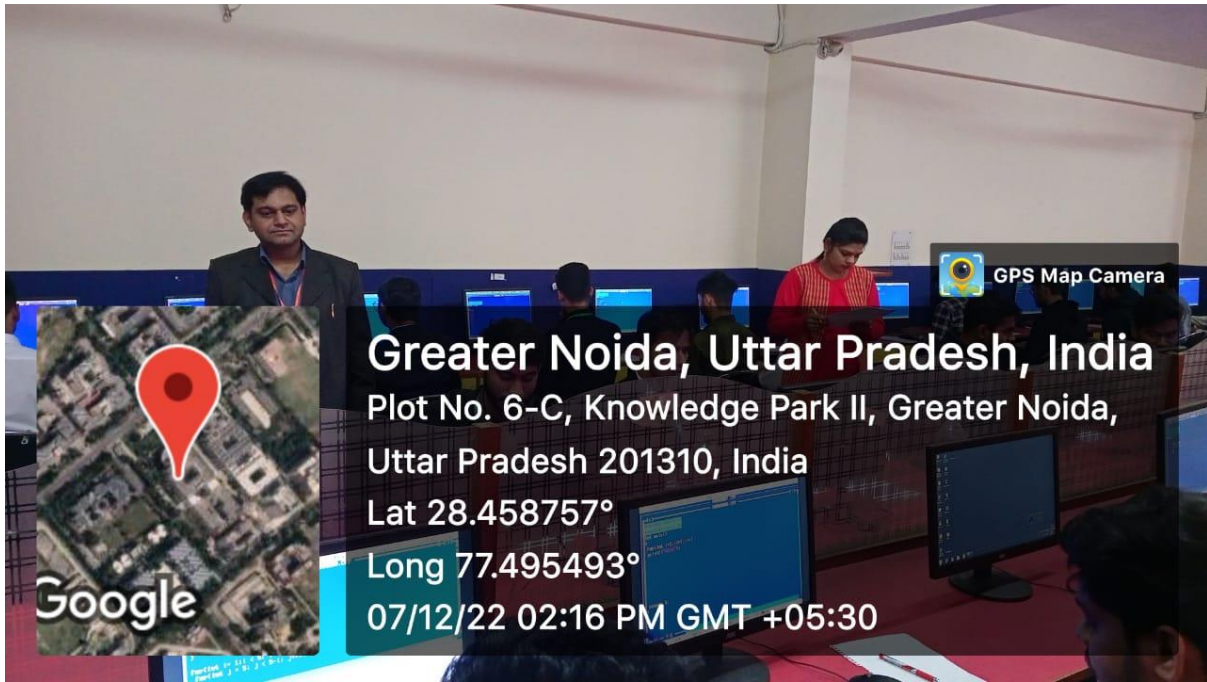


Figure 4 Mr. Krishna Kumar & Ms. Soniya Sharma giving the suggestions during coding Competition.

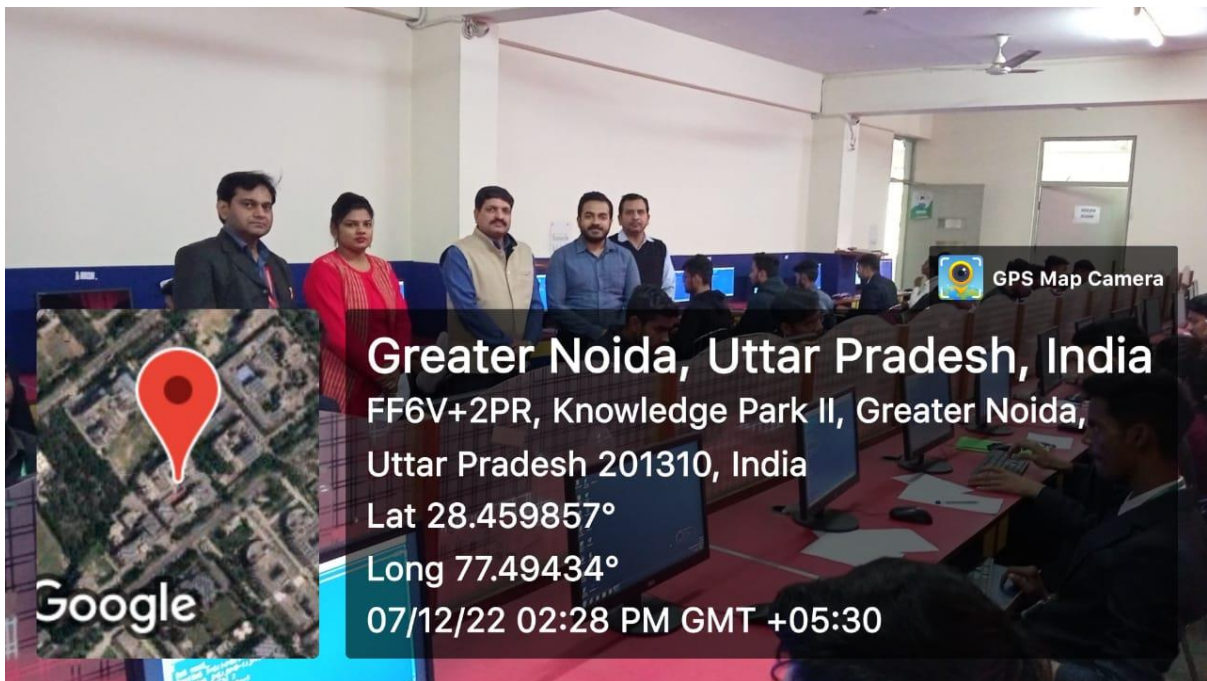


Figure 5 During Coding Competition Mr. Aayush Mangal (VC, MGI), Mr. Abhay N Tripathi, Mr. Krishna Kumar, Ms. Soniya Sharma with IT Manager Mr. Omendra Kumar.
