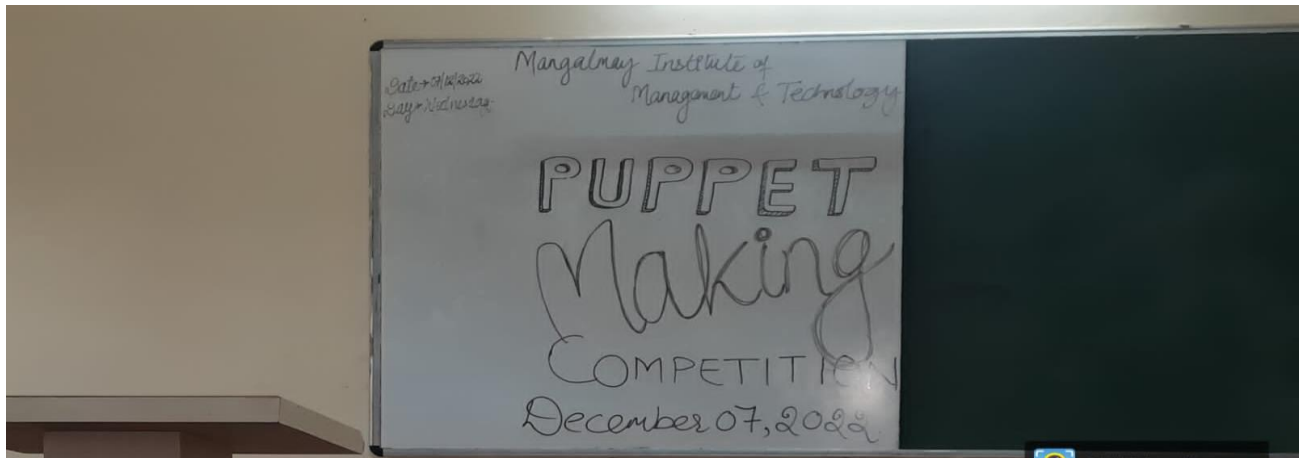

To encourage imagination and creativity amongst the students, School of Education organized a "Puppet Making Competition" for B.A.B.Ed. I, II, III & IV Year students. A puppet is an object, often resembling a human, animal or mythical figure, that is animated or manipulated by a person called a puppeteer. Puppetry is a very ancient form of Theatre. Puppeteers may take any form, but it shares the process of animating inanimate performing objects to tell a story. There are many different varieties of puppets, and they are made from a wide range of materials, depending on their form and intended use.
Objective	The objective behind organizing " Puppet Making Competition " is to: 1-To develop the creative talent of the students and to encourage the craftsmanship and artfulness of the students. 2-To create interaction, fun dialogue and even an element of surprise in your play and learn activities. 3-To showcase their talent by creating colorful and vibrant Puppets.
