



Content	Rangoli is an art form that originates from in the Indian subcontinent, in which patterns are created on the floor or a tabletop using materials such as powdered lime stone, red ochre, dry rice flour, colored sand, quartz powder, flower petals, and colored rocks. Rangoli designs can be simple geometric shapes, depictions of deities, or flower and petal shapes appropriate to the given celebrations. The purpose of rangoli is decoration, and it is thought to bring good luck as well. Keeping this in mind, "Rangoli Making Competition" was organized on 23rd November, 2022 byCultural Club, MIMT for the students of B.A.B.Ed. I,II III and IV year. Judges of the event were Mr. Ashish Srivastava and Ms.Renu and the decision regarding the winners was made on the basis of the following criteria: 1-Adherence to the theme 2-Details and clarity in the design 3-Color combination 4-Innovativeness
