Content	A riddle is a statement, question or phrase having a double or veiled meaning, put forth as a puzzle to be solved. Georges and Dundes suggested that "a riddle is a traditional verbal expression which contains one or more descriptive elements, a pair of which may be in opposition; the referent of the elements is to be guessed". Riddles are fun, challenging, and most of all, they get you thinking. One of the best ways to stimulate young minds is to engage them in some brainstorming sessions and solving riddles is the best way to enhance thinking skills of young kids. Students not only have loads of fun in solving riddles, but they also learn various new skills. Keeping this in view, Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) Club, MIMT conducted a "Riddle Giggle" for B.A.B.Ed. I, II, III & IV students on 09th November, 2022.
Objective	The objective behind organizing " Riddle Giggle " is to: 1-To improve children's comprehension and creativity. 2-To learn new words and new ways to use them, subliminally learning rhythm and rhyming. 3-To improve concentration and interpretation skills. 4-To foster critical thinking and problem-solving skills among children.
Outcome	In total 223 students participated in the activity. It supported student's problem solving, logic and critical thinking skills. It developed the concentration, focus and brain dexterity. Riddles had improved children's comprehension and creativity. They learned new words and new ways to use them, subliminally learning rhythm and rhyming.
