



Ohioativo	A tongue twister is a specific sequence of words whose rapid, repeated pronunciation is difficult even for native speakers. Often these are similar words which follow one another but differ in certain syllables. Alliterations are also frequent. Tongue-twisters are language games used cross-linguistically in order to help students develop clear speech and practice the pronunciation of difficult words. In addition, they require a high level of concentration. Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) Club, MIMTorganized "Tongue Twister Activity" on 21st September, 2022 to reinforce comprehension and production of complex segments, consonant clusters, syllabic structures and accentual patterns of the target language at the phonological level.
